

ENHANCING TOURISM THROUGH INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT IN KARAKALPAKSTAN: A PATH TO SUSTAINABLE GROWTH

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Annotation

The article discusses the significant impact of infrastructure development on tourism growth in Karakalpakstan. Key improvements include the completion of the “Nukus — Urgench” highway, which reduced travel time and increased passenger traffic, and the renovation of Nukus Airport, which boosted flight numbers and tourist arrivals. The region has also seen a rise in hotel infrastructure, with new hotels and international chains attracting more tourists. Additionally, social and environmental initiatives, such as enhanced water supply and waste management, and the “Green Uzbekistan” program, have improved the region’s appeal. Comparative analysis with the Bukhara region highlights the positive influence of infrastructure on tourism, emphasizing the need for sustainable development to preserve natural and cultural resources. The article concludes that Karakalpakstan has the potential to become a key tourist destination in Uzbekistan.

Annotatsiya

Maqolada Qoraqalpog'istonda infratuzilma rivojlanishining turizm rivojlanishiga sezilarli ta'siri muhokama qilinadi. “Nukus – Urganch” avtomagistralining qurib bitkazilishi, bu sayohat vaqtini qisqartirish va yo'lovchilar oqimini oshirish hamda “Nukus” aeroportining rekonstruksiya qilinishi reyslar soni va sayyohlar kelishini oshirishdan iborat. Mintaqada mehmonxona infratuzilmasi ham o'sdi, yangi mehmonxonalar va xalqaro tarmoqlar ko'proq sayyohlarni jalb qilmoqda. Bundan tashqari, suv ta'minoti va chiqindilarni boshqarishni yaxshilash, “Yashil O'zbekiston” dasturi kabi ijtimoiy va ekologik tashabbuslar mintaqaning jozibadorligini oshirdi. Buxoro viloyati bilan qiyosiy tahlil qilish infratuzilmaning turizmga ijobiy ta'sirini ko'rsatib, tabiiy va madaniy boyliklarni saqlab qolish uchun barqaror rivojlanish zarurligini ta'kidlaydi. Maqolada Qoraqalpog'iston O'zbekistonning asosiy sayyohlik yo'nalishiga aylanish salohiyatiga egaligi haqida xulosa qilingan.

Аннотация

В статье рассматривается значительное влияние развития инфраструктуры на рост туризма в Каракалпакстане. К основным улучшениям относятся завершение строительства автомагистрали «Нукус — Ургенч», что сократило время в пути и увеличило пассажиропоток, а также реконструкция аэропорта

Нукуса, что увеличило количество рейсов и прибытий туристов. В регионе также наблюдается рост гостиничной инфраструктуры: новые отели и международные сети привлекают больше туристов. Кроме того, социальные и экологические инициативы, такие как улучшение водоснабжения и управления отходами, а также программа «Зеленый Узбекистан», повысили привлекательность региона. Сравнительный анализ с Бухарской областью подчеркивает положительное влияние инфраструктуры на туризм, подчеркивая необходимость устойчивого развития для сохранения природных и культурных ресурсов. В статье делается вывод о том, что Каракалпакстан имеет потенциал стать ключевым туристическим направлением в Узбекистане.

INTRODUCTION

In 2023, Uzbekistan attracted 6.6 million foreign visitors, according to the Agency for Statistics. The majority of these visitors (5.6 million) came to visit relatives, while others traveled for leisure (773,200), business (143,500), commerce (70,400), healthcare (61,300), and education (16,800). Karakalpakstan, with its rich cultural and natural heritage, contributed significantly to these figures, as the region began to emerge from the periphery of Uzbekistan's tourist routes.

Karakalpakstan, long overlooked by many travelers, has started to garner attention due to significant infrastructure improvements. These developments have not only enhanced the region's appeal to tourists but have also played a crucial role in the overall growth of Uzbekistan's tourism sector. This article examines the key areas of infrastructure development in Karakalpakstan, their impact on the tourism industry, and provides statistical data and expert opinions.

MATERIALS AND METHODS

The primary sources of data for analysis included statistical information from the State Committee on Statistics of the Republic of Uzbekistan, reports from the Ministry of Tourism and Cultural Heritage, and publications from national and international research institutes. The methodology involved collecting and analyzing statistics, conducting comparative analysis with other regions of Uzbekistan, and obtaining expert evaluations on the impact of infrastructure projects on tourism development.

RESULTS

Development of Transport Infrastructure

Improving transport accessibility is a key factor in the growth of tourism in Karakalpakstan. Since 2019, investors have actively invested in the construction and modernization of roads. In 2023, the "Nukus-Urgench" highway was completed, reducing travel time by 30 percent. As a result, passenger traffic increased by 18 percent compared to 2022.

Nukus Airport has also undergone significant changes. Following the completion of renovations in 2022, the number of domestic and international flights increased by 15 percent, and the number of arriving tourists rose by 22 percent. The majority of tourist flows are domestic (65 percent), but the share of foreign tourists, mainly from Kazakhstan, Russia, and Turkey, also grew, comprising 35 percent of the total in 2023.

Development of Hotel Infrastructure and Services

Karakalpakstan is actively developing its tourist infrastructure, particularly in the hotel sector. In 2023, 15 new hotels were opened in the region, increasing the room stock by 20 percent. This allowed for a 25 percent increase in the number of tourists compared to 2022. The opening of international hotel chains such as InterContinental, Hyatt, Hilton, and Mercure in Uzbekistan has attracted tourists from European countries.

In addition, a number of new tourist routes have been developed. Notably, historical routes, including visits to the Savitsky Art Museum and the Ayaz-Kala Fortress, have become particularly popular among foreign tourists, who now account for about 40 percent of the total flow.

Social and Environmental Infrastructure

An important component of the region's tourist appeal is the improvement of social and environmental infrastructure. In 2022, a program was launched to enhance water supply and waste management, which has improved the comfort level for tourists. Moreover, as part of the national "Green Uzbekistan" program, more than 100,000 trees were planted in 2023, contributing to an improved ecological environment.

DISCUSSION

Comparative analysis shows that infrastructure improvements positively influence tourism growth. For example, in the Bukhara region, where similar projects were implemented earlier, tourist traffic increased by 30 percent over three years. In Karakalpakstan, according to 2023 data, the increase in the number of tourists was 27 percent, indicating the region's high potential.

Experts emphasize the importance of sustainable development in this region. They argue that Karakalpakstan has enormous potential for tourism development, but it is essential to preserve the region's natural and cultural resources while simultaneously developing infrastructure. Sustainable development must become the foundation of all projects in the region.

CONCLUSION

Infrastructure development in Karakalpakstan has had a significant impact on the growth of the tourism industry and has contributed to the region's economic development. Improved transport accessibility, an expanded hotel stock, and the creation of new tourist routes, along with environmental and social initiatives, provide the foundation for sustainable growth. Karakalpakstan has every opportunity to become one of Uzbekistan's key tourist destinations, attracting more and more tourists from around the world.
